Northwestern on COVID's Impact in Lowand Middle-Income Countries

Northwestern Univesity expands on results from <u>a paper in February 2021</u> on the economic impact of COVID-19 in nine lower- and middle-income countries. Overall, findings showed the pandemic took a significant toll on key livelihood outcomes—including food security, employment, and domestic violence—across several LMICs and that the economic shock will have long-term consequences. <u>Dean Karlan</u> and <u>Chris Udry</u> discuss the challenges of developing the phone surveys used in the study and how this data can be used to determine a path forward. For example, <u>emergency cash transfers in Togo</u> were found to be an effective short-term solution.
