Can education help prevent HIV/AIDS?

Yes (at least in the short term).

We <u>did a study</u> in 2003-2006 with the Kenyan Ministry of Education and a non-profit *International Child Support*. In their <u>Analysis</u>, Esther Duflo, Pascaline Dupas and Michael Kremer found positive results both from training teachers in the national AIDS curriculum, and providing incentives for girls to stay in school.

As for longer-term impacts, we are currently implementing a <u>follow-up study</u>, tracking down twenty thousand students from the initial study to see how they are doing today.
